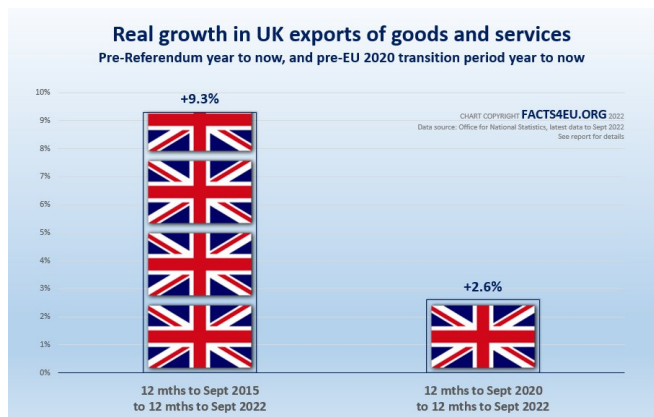

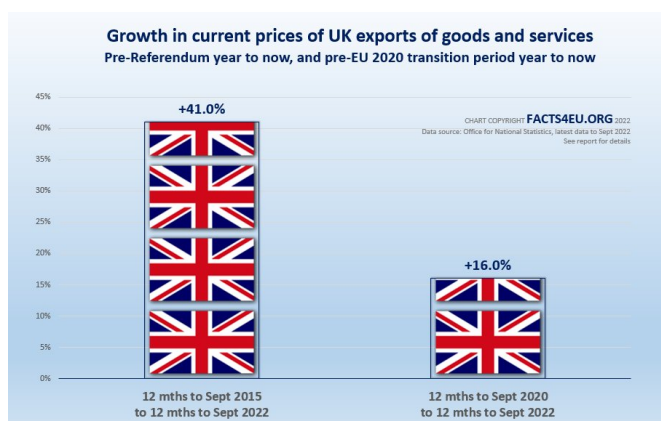


- **UP 9.3%** – Since the vote to leave on 23 June 2016 – UP
- **UP 2.6%** – Since we left the EU’s ‘transition period’ on 31 Dec 2020 – UP

2. Using ‘Current Prices’ – actual value of exports in each time period



- **UP 41.0%** – Since the vote to leave on 23 Jun 2016 – UP
- **UP 16.0%** – Since we left the EU’s ‘transition period’ on 31 Dec 2020 – UP
