Inflation – lower in Brexit Britain than in the EU



The most commonly used measure of inflation shows that things are worse in the EU

CIBUK (https://cibuk.org/) – the longest-established organisation for freedom, independence and sovereignty in the UK – has just published a report on inflation in the UK and EU, produced with our affiliated organisation Facts4EU.org.

When the latest inflation figures came out on Wednesday (22 June 2022), many of 'the usual suspects' were quick to insinuate that Brexit was to blame – at least in part. Those who made international comparisons – such as the BBC – failed to show that the EU has even worse problems.


Facts4EU.Org has now analysed the UK's results for CIBUK and compared them to the picture across the EU. The results are very interesting and here are some highlights.

Consumer Prices Index including owner occupiers' housing costs (CPIH)

Annual increase – latest figures released for May 2022

• UK : 7.9%

• EU: 8.8%



The price of a loaf of bread – and all other food and non-alcoholic drinks Annual increase – latest figures released for May 2022

UK: 8.7%EU: 10.0%



It is abundantly clear from the data around the world including Europe that inflation is a world-wide phenomenon and not one caused by the UK's decision to leave the EU.
