Bosnia & Herzegovina is latest impoverished country to receive EU 'candidate status'



Fears over the current "invasion of the South Coast" will get a whole lot worse following the decision of the EU to grant 'candidate status' to Bosnia & Herzegovina.

- It joins four other Western Balkans countries: Albania, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Montenegro, and Serbia.
- The sixth, Kosovo is on the way. Kosovo is not yet even recognised as a country by the United Nations.

Ever since the Brexit Referendum the EU has been desperate to sign up new members. Here is the reaction from the former Vice-President of the EU Commission in 2017:


“The big loser of the game that currently is being played will be the UK.”
