

"Brexit has definitely not been done," say politicians in Parliament and in NI

Angered by the EU, key figures react to our report of EU legal actions in the UK.

Using expressions such as "Applies a wrecking ball to our Union" and "We are not a sovereign country", the temperature is once again rising over the EU's actions.



<u>CIBUK's report yesterday</u> detailing the number of new legal cases that have been brought by the EU since the UK left, has shocked even seasoned political professionals.

Today, Campaign for an Independent Britain - CIBUK (https://cibuk.org/) – the oldest-established organisation for independence, freedom and democracy in the UK – and its affiliate Facts4EU.Org – provide the comments we have received on our report, from the House of Commons to the House of Lords, to the MLA in Northern Ireland.
