

EU plan to split up United Kingdom now in tatters according to latest poll

By 2 to 1 the Northern Irish reject unification and thereby reject re-joining the EU



Attempts to split the UK as punishment for leaving the EU now lie in tatters according to a recent poll for the Irish Times.


Contrary to the hopes of the EU, the Irish Republic and Sinn Fein, Northern Irish voters made it abundantly clear there have no desire for a 'united Ireland'. They prefer to stay in the non-EU United Kingdom by a majority of almost two to one.

Campaign for an Independent Britain - CIBUK (https://cibuk.org/) – the oldest-established organisation for independence, freedom and democracy in the UK – and its affiliate Facts4EU.Org – are delighted to share the results of the latest major opinion poll which shows overwhelming support in Northern Ireland for remaining part of the United Kingdom.

Of those who expressed a preference, the poll found:

Want N.I. to stay in UK: 64.9%

Want N.I. to leave UK and unify with South: 35.1%



Commenting, CIBUK's Communications Director Ben Philips said:

"Polling was undertaken in August and September among more than 1,000 voters on both sides of the Irish border, comprehensively giving lie to the claim among Euro enthusiasts that Northern Ireland is about to break away from the rest of the United Kingdom and rush headlong back into the arms of the EU. We will do our best to persuade the Foreign Secretary and the FCO to lend their weight behind the result by drawing it to the attention of the US Administration. Whether they do so or not is an entirely different matter."
