"Brexit was a means to an end, not an end in itself. And that's really important - some people think we did Brexit and that's it. But what Brexit was about was the restoration of democratic controls to the people of the United Kingdom."

On Immigration and the ECHR:

"[Previously] if you came from a country that was deemed to be safe and claimed asylum, you were returned. That is the sort of thing that we ought to return to, so that if you're coming from Albania, you get returned."

On Deregulation:

"...we should not be penalising British industry and moving jobs and economic activity abroad for no reason.

"We should cut great swathes of the [EU] product regulations away, to allow people to sell products that pass a safety test..."

On the Northern Ireland Protocol:

"Protecting the [EU] Single Market is not the business of His Majesty's Government. That's a matter for the European Union."

On Geopolitics:

"...do I think Russia or China is the biggest long-term threat to the UK? I think it's China rather than Russia."
