
**The Home Office is accepting more EU migrants EACH MONTH than all the illegal migrants who have crossed the Channel THIS YEAR.**

- **Total : 6,874,700**
- **Concluded : 6,686,530**
- **Approved : 6,036,440 (90.3%)**



**TOTAL APPROVALS BY THE HOME OFFICE since legal deadline passed: 862,450**  
**TOTAL APPROVALS by the Home Office this year alone : 402,270**

**Commenting, CIBUK's Communications Director Ben Philips said:**

*"The closer one looks at these statistics, the more shocking they become. The promise to take back control has never sounded hollow. The situation would be laughable were it not so serious. Next to defending the nation-state, control of our borders was a major factor in driving people to vote to leave the EU. The sheer numbers given settled status by the Home Office represents more than a slap in the face to those who campaigned for controlled migration. It is nothing less than a breach of trust, and the sense of betrayal around the country at what is now happening can only be imagined."*
