Latest figures show that more than **10 MILLION people** now living permanently in England and Wales were not born anywhere in the United Kingdom.

And these figures do not even include Scotland or Northern Ireland whose census data is due for release later this year.

Campaign for an Independent Britain - CIBUK (https://cibuk.org/) – the oldest-established organisation for independence, freedom and democracy in the UK – and its affiliate Facts4EU.Org – lay bare the alarming rise in net migration into the country after detailed analysis of the latest data from the ONS.

Migrants from the EU27 : 3,632,470

• Migrants from the rest of the world (NON-EU): 6,389,005

Total: 10,021,475

A little twist

If the Scots and Northern Irish living in England and Wales are added to the above, then it means the English and Welsh are sharing their homelands with nearly 11 million (10,868,240) people who were born elsewhere. That's almost one in five.
